Cam Tran Announces Planned Closure of Chilliwack Facility

CHILLIWACK, British Columbia – July 10, 2026 – Cam Tran recently announced plans to close its Chilliwack manufacturing facility, with operations expected to cease on August 28, 2026.

"This was an extremely difficult decision because of the impact on our employees and the Chilliwack community," said Marco Barbosa, President of Cam Tran. "We are deeply grateful for the dedication and contributions of our Chilliwack team. While a number of factors influenced this decision, including economic pressures, changing market conditions, rising costs, and tariffs, our focus is on ensuring the long-term strength and competitiveness of our business while supporting employees through this transition."

The company has informed employees of the decision and is committed to supporting affected team members throughout the transition. Support measures will include a combination of working notice and severance benefits where applicable, career transition assistance, and opportunities to apply for open positions at other Cam Tran locations when available.

Cam Tran remains committed to its Canadian operations and will continue to operate five facilities across Canada, employing more than 400 employees. The company will continue to serve customers across Canada while investing in its core operations and future growth.

Operations at the Chilliwack facility will be shut down in phases over the coming months to ensure safe and orderly closure. Cam Tran will continue working closely with employees, customers, and community stakeholders throughout the transition.
